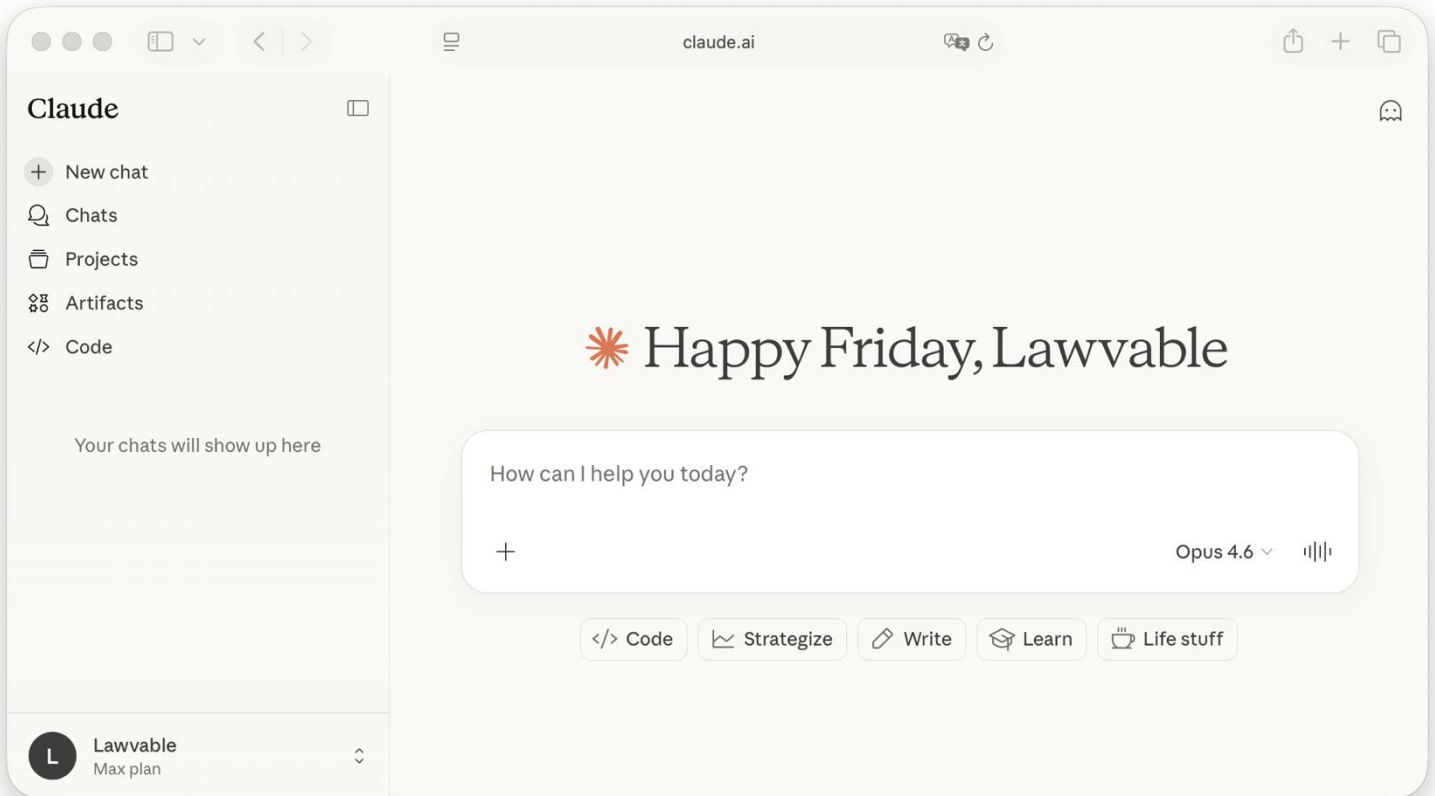

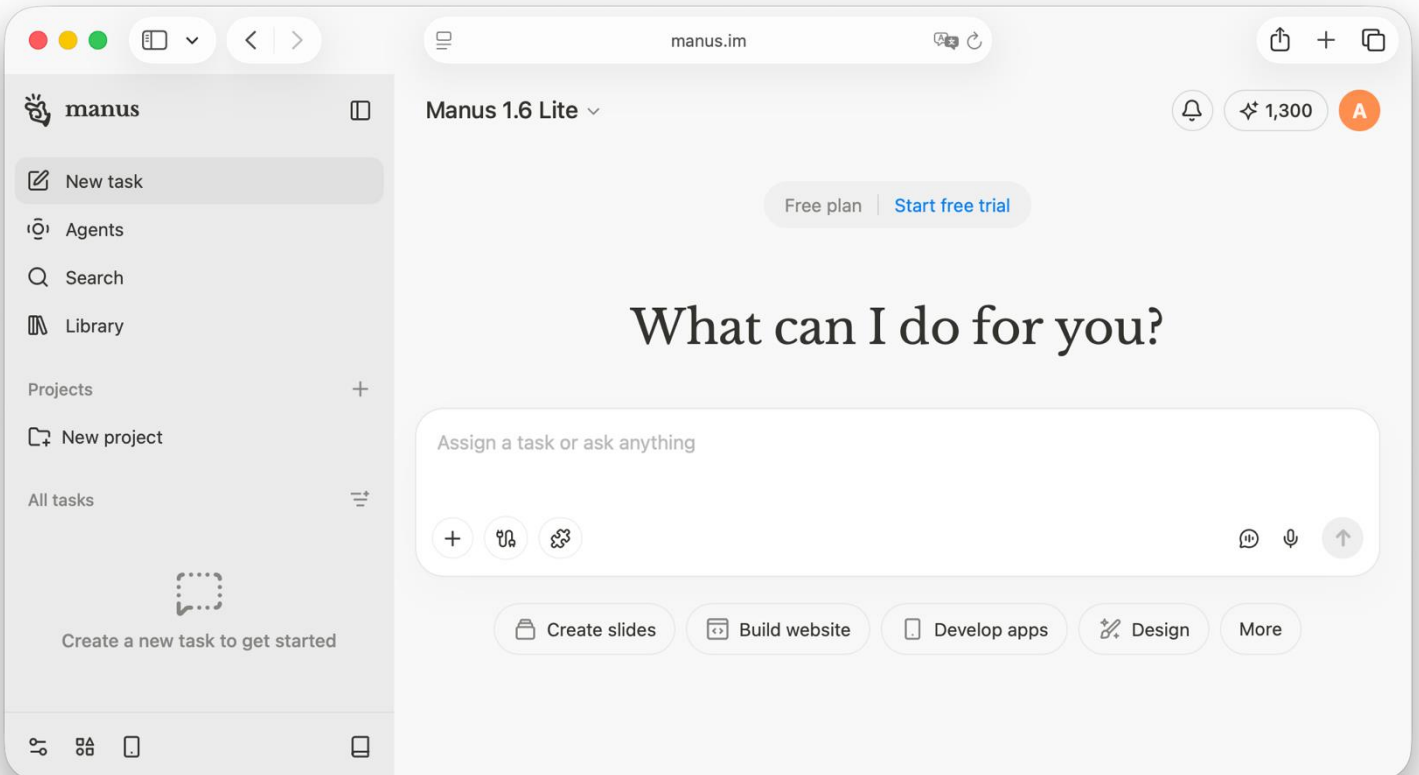
1. Download a Skill you like from lawvable.com.

5. Click on "New chat" in the left sidebar and try:

Hey Claude, can you run my new "downloaded-skill-name" Skill?



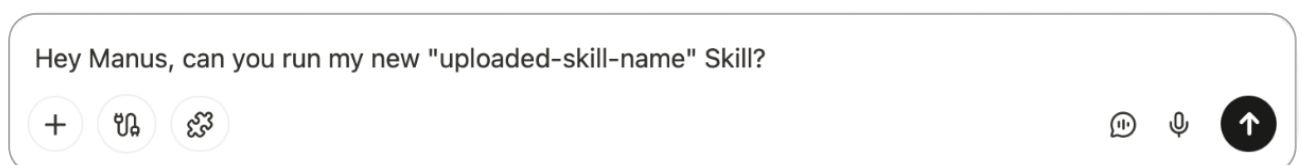

4. Enter the message below and click the send button:



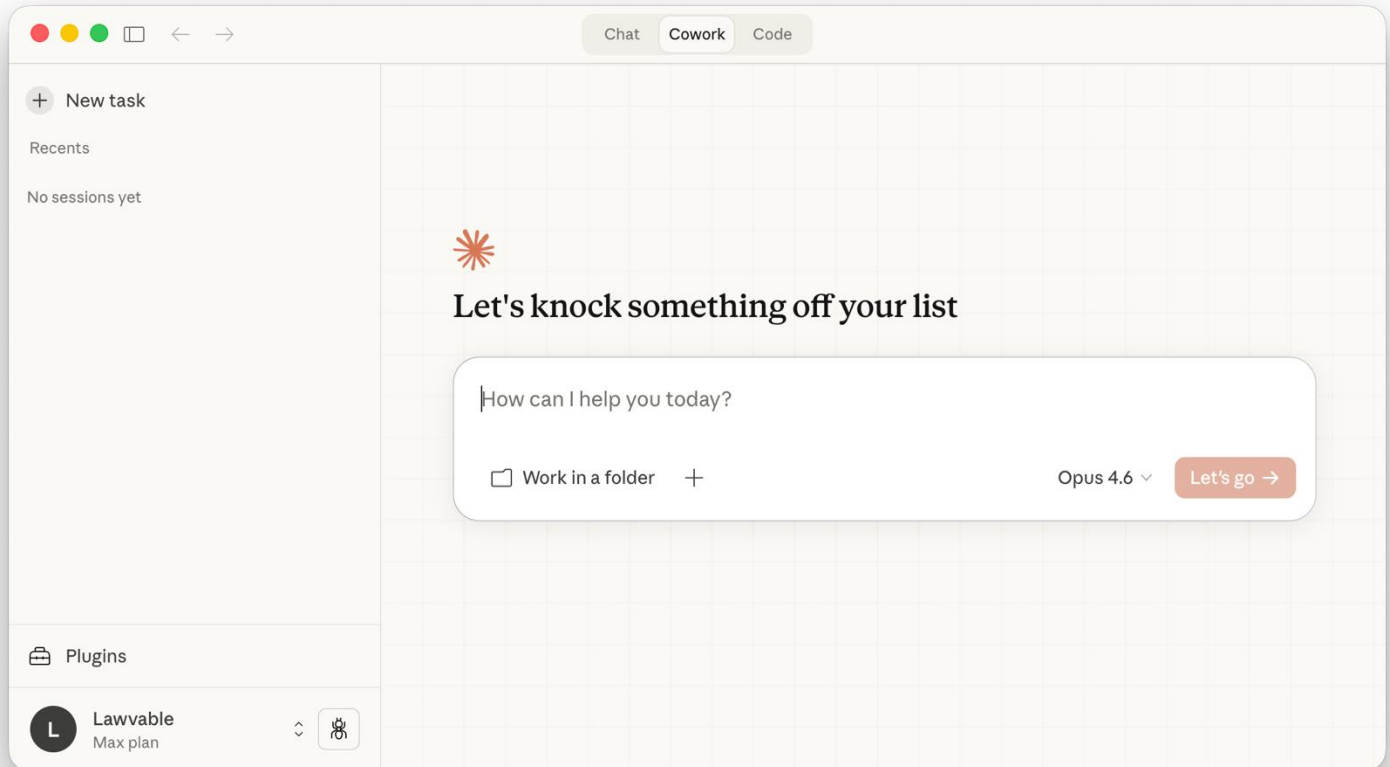
