How to build a daily digest with Claude in Cowork —
modular, automated, secure.

Pick your scope.

The digest is modular — three levels of depth, depending on what you want and what you can connect.

News only

Headlines on topics, sectors and regions you care about. A simple data-gathering exercise across public web sources.

+ Today's calendar

A line-by-line view of your meetings, so you walk in with the schedule in mind.

+ Inbox & Teams to-do list

Tasks pulled from your work email and chats. The most powerful version of the digest.

The catch: Outlook is read-only.

The official Microsoft 365 connector for Claude lets the AI read your inbox and calendar, but not write to them. So delivering the digest into your morning routine needs a workaround.

Three workarounds that work:

- **Google Calendar invite**

Cowork creates a Google Calendar event with the digest in the body; Outlook auto-adds it as a tentative meeting.

- **Local file + browser popup**

Cowork writes the digest to a local HTML file. Windows Task Scheduler opens it in your browser at the chosen time.

- **Outlook Classic .ics import**

Cowork writes a calendar file; Outlook Classic opens it as a meeting form for you to add to the calendar.

Set it up in 5 steps.

5–10 minutes depending on scope. Mostly answering questions; Claude does the building.

- 1 Download the Setup Guide MD file from the link on the last slide.
- 2 Open a fresh Cowork chat and attach the MD file.
- 3 Type: “Read this guide and follow it — set me up with a daily digest.”
- 4 Answer Claude's questions: scope, news topics, time, delivery method.
- 5 Claude builds the skill, schedules the task, walks you through any one-time Windows setup.
